Using Bold and Rigorous Approaches: Transformative R01 from the NIH Director's High Risk High Reward Program
Wednesday, March 4, 2026

We will describe a bold and rigorous approach to transforming primary care with disruptive innovations. Grounded in community-engaged systems science, the project combines group model building, simulation modeling, and the ORBIT translational framework to map specific structural determinants, identify leverage points for disruptive change, and refine innovative strategies through computational testing. By integrating community-based participatory methods with behavioral, organizational, and systems theory, this research establishes a new paradigm for defining and refining multilevel interventions that can shift policies, practices, and provider behavior. We preserved scientific rigor while adapting to new executive orders by systematically documenting required changes, integrating them into our established community-engagement and ORBIT benchmarks, and ensuring that all protocol modifications maintained methodological fidelity, transparency, and protection of partners.
